

Robbers prey on tattersalls

AN alarming increase in armed robberies at tattersalls in the greater Durban area has led to the tightening of security at these venues, but the hold-ups are still occurring.

The latest robbery took place last night when four gunmen stormed the Reservoir Hills Tattersalls and held up staff and made off with cash.

Last week there were three robberies.

Since July 19 tattersalls have been robbed.

Chief investigator of Justicia Investigations Reggie Horne said he was asked by the Natal Bookmakers' Society to advise owners on how to beef up their security measures.

Having noted the increase in armed robberies, the Durban Serious and Violent Crimes unit has also begun investigations into the crimes, said Capt Eugene van Tonder.
